Australia is calling you Young adult parishioners are invited to think about a trip to Australia! In July 2008 the next WYD takes place in Sydney Australia. There will be some preliminary meetings so that the Nottingham Diocese's young people get to know each other before the event. I am ready to look for and find sponsors for half the fare (and maybe a bit more! Who knows?). Participants must be 18 on or before 8th July 2008. There is a website www.wyd2008.org and there is a local phone number for more information. At the level of our parish, we will look for sponsors and host parish events to help with the finances. Here's hoping somebody will nibble the carrot and do a better job than our cricket team.

In 2006 the parish had 10 weddings (mostly non-parishioners), 6 Confirmations, 4 Baptisms and 1 funeral. Some other general information I share with you is the following. On average we have about 150 people attending weekly services: this includes **all celebrations**. Weekly collections average about £400.00 (£2.66 per adult); 27 people attended our Deanery Holy Hour last November; 35 attended the Advent carol service and 19 the Penance service. 50 attended Mass on New Year's Day and 5 parishioners responded to the recent appeal for more Gift Aid support. Saturday morning workshops for readers, altar servers and Eucharistic ministers were well attended and seemed to fulfil a parish need. Statistics are not everything, it is true, but they must be born in mind as together we try to administer the parish and think towards its future. May this New Year of 2007 be a year of peace and blessings for us all and, if you have any suggestions to make, please feel free to do so. Fr Hugh
