Parish Diary for February:

21st – Ash Wednesday – day of abstinence and fasting. Mass in Hassop at 10.00a.m. and in Bakewell at 7.30p.m. In the language of the Church, Lent is described as a **privileged season**. This means, as in Advent, that the People of God are invited to focus on the message of this liturgical season in a personal or, perhaps, in a family way. Nottingham Diocese has prepared the little booklet **WALK WITH ME** along with a very helpful calendar. They are available in both churches along with the CAFOD booklets.

Wednesday evenings in Lent – adult catechesis in the Narthex, Bakewell Church beginning on 28th February at 7.30pm.

OTUKPO MISSION Last year in Lent parishioners had an opportunity to support a **'low profile mission project'**.
