Parish Diary for March

Next Wednesday evening – at 7.30p.m. We have the last of our Adult Catechesis reflections on the Sacraments. Fr. Alan Burbridge from Derby will be with us and will speak about the Sacraments of Healing in our lives. He holds regular Healing Services at St George's Church in Derby. Fr. Alan is the only guest speaker invited for these Wednesday evenings so I hope we will make the effort to join him in Bakewell. Maybe you have something to say? Maybe you have something to learn? Come and join us for an hour or so. Sad to say, numbers have not been very impressive so far.

Friday evenings: Stations of the Cross at 7.30p.m. in Bakewell Church until Good Friday when the Stations will be at 11-00am in Bakewell.

24th March: Mini-retreat in preparation for Holy Week led by Fr. Dominic Milroy OSB in Hassop Church 10.00a.m. to 1.00p.m. This is intended to be an ecumenical time of retreat so do feel free to invite friends to come along with you and the parishioners of neighbouring parishes. Bring some lunch to share afterwards if you wish.

31st March: Service of Reconciliation 11.00a.m. in Hassop Church with Canon Bernard Needham, Fr Michael Horrax and Fr Hugh. Perhaps there will be a visiting priest. This will be an opportunity to seek forgiveness together in the Sacrament of Penance. This is an experiment holding this service on a Saturday morning. It is an opportunity for the whole parish community to come together as pilgrim people to seek God's forgiveness. The prophet Joel says, **"Call the people together, summon the community, the elders, the children even the infants at the breast... Let them say 'Spare your people, Lord!'"**

A small carton clearly marked for the Otukpo Lent Mission Project is in place in both churches. Please give it your support. All proceeds will go to the Otukpo community.
