Friday evening: in Bakewell until Good Friday when the Stations are at 11-00am in Bakewell.

31st March: Service of Reconciliation 11.00a.m. in Hassop Church with Canon Bernard Needham, Fr Michael Horrax and Fr Hugh. This will be an opportunity to seek forgiveness in the Sacrament of Penance. Holding this service on a Saturday morning is an experiment. In Advent many parishioners said it was not at a good time. Now we will see! It is an opportunity for the whole parish community to come together as pilgrim people to seek God's forgiveness. The prophet Joel says, **"Call the people together, summon the community, the elders, the children even the infants at the breast... Let them say 'Spare your people, Lord!'"**
