Ascension Day in England & Wales is transferred to the nearest Sunday of the 40th day after Easter. This is a big change from what we are used to in our parishes.

Pentecost Sunday will be celebrated on 27th May and the Pentecost Novena will be included in the daily Eucharistic services. **World Communications Day** is also next Sunday: this reminds us of the Church's media mission.

Some future events in parish and diocese:-
