*Padley Chapel is all that remains now of the Manor built in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. The Squires attended the parish church during the reigns of Henry VII, Henry VIII and Mary Tudor. On July 12<sup>th</sup> 1588, Padley Hall was visited by a search party. Two priests, Nicholas Garlick and Robert Ludlam were taken to Derby, passing through the village of Eyam ... they were eventually condemned to death with another priest Richard Simpson on July 24<sup>th</sup> 1588.*
