Bethlehem at Christmas: As we sing 'O Little Town of Bethlehem' this Christmas we should remember what Bethlehem and the surrounding villages are like now. They are surrounded by **the** wall, which the Israelis have built, and people need passes to get in or out. If it is a Jewish holiday then the gate into Bethlehem is not manned so no one can enter or leave. Tour guides cannot enter and they discourage tourists from going in on their own. The area has become a ghetto. At Garth Hewitt's recent concert we bought a little olive wood crib in which there is a wall between the baby in the manger and the shepherds and kings – a powerful reminder of the situation in Bethlehem now.
