We will be studying the York Course on The Lord's Prayer, ending with all the groups together for the final session at 7.30pm on Tuesday 11th March at Bakewell Methodist Church. The Lent Groups are an initiative of the **Association of Bakewell Christians** (ABC) and are ecumenical.

The Sick & Retired Priests' collection will be taken up after Holy Communion at Masses this weekend. Small white Gift Aid envelopes, available in both churches, with the

parish/diocese name on them can be used and marked **SRPF**. All donations and envelopes will be sent to the fund.

Ash Wednesday is on 6th February – a week next Wednesday – and it is a day of Fasting and Abstinence from meat. Primarily it is a day for some Penance in our lives. This means Easter will be very early – 23rd March. During Lent we shall have opportunities to pray a little "in tune with this special season" and, **on the Fridays of Lent**, the morning Mass will be at 11-30am instead of 9-30am. This is an experiment to see if a later time is more agreeable to some parishioners. If it does not work out, we will revert to 9-30am without any due ceremony! At present about 3-5 people attend our Friday morning Mass. The 7-30pm Stations of the Cross in Bakewell will continue on the Fridays of Lent.

Diocesan and Parish Pastoral Plans are being discussed and you can see on the notice-boards current information. Deacon John has a family commitment and is unable to attend the diocesan meeting. However, Fr Hugh, Sue Hannan and Roger Burkey will represent our parish.
