Ash Wednesday is this coming Wednesday: it is a day of Fasting and Abstinence from meat. Primarily it is a day for some Penance in our lives. During Lent we shall have opportunities to pray a little "in tune with this special season" and, **on the Fridays of Lent**, the morning Mass will be at 11-30am in Hassop instead of 9-30am. This is an experiment to see if a later time is more agreeable to some parishioners. If it does not work out, we will revert to 9-30am without any due ceremony! At present about 3-5 people attend our Friday morning Mass. The 7-30pm Stations of the Cross in Bakewell will continue on the Fridays of Lent. The Lent '**Walk with Me**' booklets and season calendars are available in both churches. The calendars are especially good for youngsters.
