They will be walking as a group from Hope and should be at the Bulls Head at Foolow between 13.30 and 14.00 (about 6 miles). **19<sup>th</sup> March** the Chrism Mass in the Cathedral with our Bishop. Anybody who wishes can go along for this Mass: it is one of the most important celebrations in the Liturgical Year.
