Wednesday 12th clergy ecumenical meeting;

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday on 16th: Morning Masses as usual with Benediction at 4-00pm. Roger Burkey has kindly agreed to plan the Readers for their very important service during Holy Week. Also, on Maundy Thursday evening, all the Altar Servers are invited to attend this solemn celebration. We had a rehearsal for this Mass last Saturday morning in Bakewell with 8 servers present.
