**Thanks to the Social Committee** and all who supported the Pea & Pie evening last Saturday. The proceeds for the evening were £351.00 and a few pence are still coming in!

**Catholic Children's Society:** Both Bishop Malcolm and Mr Steve Hargrave (CCS chief executive) have written to all parishes and supporters of the CCS to explain what is in effect a major decision for the Society. This decision is a direct consequence of the Government's Equality Act and affects the CCS status as a Catholic voluntary agency. Copies of both letters are available and on display.

**Money Matters (always catch the eye!):** A small group of parishioners greatly facilitate parish income by giving their support directly through bank accounts. The great advantage with this system is that it is *stable* and *regular* even when one is not with the parish family gathered for Sunday Mass because we are certainly a mobile parish! For the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2008, the parish has received £1,852 through this means all of which is Gift Aided. This could be improved upon and Parishioners, who travel frequently, may want to consider this and accept the invitation to think of us even when away.

Now that the new tax year has begun, some of you may wish to discuss our parish Gift Aid arrangements further.

**Gerry Smith** our Treasurer or **Tony Byrne** our Gift Aid coordinator can help you. If you don't know either Gerry or Tony, Fr Hugh will guide you to them. If you don't know Fr Hugh, there is a problem!!! The sad news this year is that our Gift Aid returns will be less because new tax rules have reduced the amount per £1 that can be claimed – from 28p to 25p – so more support for our parish scheme would help.
