Human Fertilisation & Embryology Bill: During the debate in Parliament on the above bill there were 8 amendments. These were:-

1. Amendment to ban Animal/Human Hybrids: Ayes 176 Noes 336
2. Amendment to ban 'Saviour Siblings': Ayes 163 Noes 342
3. Amendment on the need for a father: Ayes 217 Noes 292
4. Amendment on 12 week limit on abortion: Ayes 71 Noes 393
5. Amendment on 16 week limit on abortion: Ayes 84 Noes 387
6. Amendment on 20 week limit on abortion: Ayes 190 Noes 332
7. Amendment on 22 week limit on abortion: Ayes 233 Noes 304
8. Amendment calling for counselling where the unborn child has a physical or mental abnormality: Ayes 173 Noes 304

In all of the above amendments our MP, Patrick McLoughlin, voted for the amendments (Ayes)

However a letter has been received, signed by Lord Alton, Jim Dobbin MP and Rt. Hon Ann Widdecombe MP, urging us to continue contacting our MP as at the report stage there will be the opportunity to put before the house further amendments, as indeed also will the pro-abortion MP's.
