Money Matters (always catches the eye!): from our parishioners who support the parish directly through the

bank, the parish has received for the period April-June ending £2557.00 which is Gift Aided. It has also received through the Diocesan Gift Aid scheme a further £1527.80 from the Inland Revenue. The parish is indebted to all who use this means of support and to all of you who support the parish week by week through the weekly envelopes. These 2 main channels of income help the parish to have stability even when parishioners are absent – some for quite long periods. Personally, I am very grateful to our parishioners who help with finances viz. Gerry Smith (Treasurer), Tony Byrne (Gift Aid Coordinator) and all who count on Sundays.

Visitors and Parishioners may use the "occasional" Gift Aid envelope, available in both churches, and our Greeters should ensure that these envelopes are always available. One visitor last weekend found an envelope herself and used it. Last weekend the parish offerings were **£195.00** through the envelopes and **£151.33** loose plate. Perhaps more of us could use the envelope scheme for **our parish**. And a little bit of financial information: £20 in 2003 is worth £16.90 today, £10 equals £8.45p.
