Ash Wednesday is with us again! It is a day of fasting and abstinence in our faith community as is Good Friday. Please note the times of Masses on Wednesday. On the Fridays of Lent Mass will be at 11.30 in Hassop and a meditation on the Way of the Cross will be at 7.30pm in Bakewell. The Way of the Cross can be an ecumenical service. Please remember the **Fridays of Lent** remain days of abstinence – we remember the first Good Friday.

For Lent Activities – there are little booklets *My Day by Day* and *Day by Day Junior* (£1.50 each); CAFOD'S *Family Fast Day* will be on 6th March; in both our churches there will be boxes available to help a missionary project; our altar servers will receive a little jar for their "goodie" contributions and together we will choose which project to help. Lent is a time when we are all encouraged to think of others in need.

Sunday 1st March we celebrate the **Rite of Election** with Bishop Malcolm in the Cathedral. All adults preparing to be received into full Communion with the Church gather with the Bishop for this important step on their spiritual journey. A small group from our parish will be present with the Bishop.
