*Ash Wednesday is the start of Lent and Lent is a preparation for the Easter proclamation. During this season the Catechumens are prepared for full communion with the Church. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence.*

**During Lent** we shall try to give a little time to prayer and devotion for the spiritual life of our parish. There will also be the **CAFOD** Family Fast day on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> February. Special envelopes will be attached to the newsletter next week.

We'll also have our own **parish project**; this year we'll help a South African orphanage where there are many young children whose parents have died from AIDS. Fr Peter Lafferty CSSp (known to Juliet Peel after her visit in 2008) runs this orphanage with his helpers. So, we invite all parishioners who wish to take home a **LENT JAR** available in both churches. Some of you probably have your charity jars at home all the time but this is our parish family's project. The Altar Servers, the R.E. group and our young people should all be encouraged to enter into the spirit of Lent which is one of learning about self-giving in word and in deed. At the end of Lent, the money will be collected and sent to help the orphanage.

**On the Fridays of Lent** Mass (or Holy Communion service) will be at 11.30am in Hassop followed by a *very short* thought or two based on the Way of the Cross. There will be a bowl of soup and a roll after Mass in the parish rooms and volunteers to help with the rota for this are needed. Juliet Peel is coordinating it. In the evenings on Fridays of Lent at 7pm, we will have the usual meditation on the Way of the Cross in Bakewell church which is open to all.

**Prof. Edward Hulmes** will lead a Lent talk on Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> March at 7.30pm in the parish rooms. Entitled 'Return to *Muqaybleh*: a Lenten meditation' it's open to all who would like to come and, please, invite friends and non-parishioners.
