'The Easter Triduum is the culmination of the entire Liturgical Year. The Triduum begins with the Mass on Maundy Thursday, reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil. On Good Friday and Holy Saturday, until the Vigil, a fast is observed.'

Holy Week is with us once again. Clearly the Liturgy should bind us together during these days. On Wednesday the Cathedral will be packed with the Faithful along with Priests and Deacons gathered around Bishop Malcolm. It is always a moving Liturgy and our parishioners will be in our thoughts and prayers as Deacon John & Elizabeth and I gather for this solemn celebration of the Eucharist and the Blessing of Oils.

At our parish level, there are opportunities to use the Liturgy to help us to pray and to remind us of the Church all over the world which celebrates Easter. The **Sacred Triduum** is our reason for prayer Fr Hugh.
