Our parish has been allocated 16 seats only on the Deanery coach. The Beatification Mass will be at 9.30am on Sunday, 19th September at Cofton Park, Birmingham. Pilgrims have to be in their places by 8.30am. Young parishioners must be accompanied by adults and there is a cost of £25.00 per adult. If we have some young parishioners attending (those still at school), we shall help with a special parish collection for their expenses. Those going will meet the coach at St Benedict's School in Derby and, to facilitate this, arrangements for lifts will be made. Unfortunately, there will be some walking involved after the coach trip. The cut-off date for our reserved 16 seats is next Sunday so Jane will need to know very quickly.
