**A bit of Good News:** Peak National Park has also responded to the appeal to donate towards the repairs on the cemetery wall and have promised £250.00. **And some Bad News:** the Diocese of Nottingham financial quota for our parish stands at £7,214.00 for 2010-2011. This means the diocesan finance department *automatically* withdraws £601.00 per month from the parish. You don't like this and I certainly don't like it but, now that the Diocese employs many more lay people in its administration, some salaries for these employees are high. A very good question was asked last Thursday evening at the PPC: is this level of spending and the way of levying each parish *sustainable*? Whilst we cannot foresee the future and the adaptations that will be made in the Church's Mission, I think parishioners are quite right to ask questions about "the quota system".
