Mission Martyrs in 2010 were Frs José Luis Parra Puerto (aged 50), Dejair Gonçalves de Almeida (32), Román de Jesús Zapata (51), Esteban Robert Wood (68), Peter Bombacha (74), Ruben Gonçalves (35), Joseph Zhang Shulai (55) Carlos Wotto (83), Herminio Alumia (36), Linán Morales (80), Wasim Sabieh & Thair Saad Abdal (both in their 20s still, killed in Baghdad), Christian Bakulene, Bernardo Amaral (28) and Miroslaw Karczewski (45). Also, Bishop Luigi Padovese (64) was stabbed to death. A number of other martyrs whose deaths are recorded in **MISSIO** spring 2011 are on pp 10-13.
