**Archbishop Raymond-Marie Tchidimbo CSSp** died on 26<sup>th</sup> March in France. In 1970 he was sentenced to life imprisonment by Sékou Touré of Guinea Conakry and was released in August 1979 and sent into exile. He wrote a little book about his prison experience, **"A Bishop's Novitiate"**. He will be buried in Guinea in the near future.
