Cardinal Kazimierz Świątel died on 21st July: he had a long life: here are a few of the highlights – born 1914 in Estonia ... lived during the Russian Revolution of 1917 ... his family was deported to Siberia when he was three years old ... ordained a priest April 1939 ... arrested April 1941 and imprisoned ... he escaped and was again arrested on 18th December 1944 and imprisoned in Minsk. In 1945 he was condemned to forced-labour in the mines of Siberia. Finally released in 1954, he returned to Pinsk where he resumed his pastoral work and became bishop.

Famine in East Africa: some parishioners have asked about having a special collection as our response to the ever-worsening situation that we see daily on our television sets in Kenya, Somalia and Ethiopia. As we know only too well, a solution is not easy because of the very difficult political reality found in these countries. I suppose the question for us as a parish community is, *'Should we do something or just ignore the plight of millions of people?'* If parishioners want to do something through the **Disaster Emergency Committee**, there is plenty of information on the internet. If you prefer to give support in another way, I will now quote a message I received from Fr Brendan Smyth this week:

'Dear Hugh,

Hello! I am aware that so many people are touched by the crisis in East Africa, I can tell you it is taking up a lot of our time and energy here. We have been fortunate to have received some money to help our confreres who are on the ground in the affected areas, mainly Kenya, but also including Ethiopia. If you like, you can send money to me here in Brussels and I will ensure that it gets to the people who need it most, without one penny being used for administration. Fraternally, Brendan (Smyth)
