**This weekend** we recall the visit of Pope Benedict last year when Cardinal Newman was beatified.

**Ján Korec** has just celebrated 60 years as a Bishop. His story is very interesting. He was secretly ordained Bishop at the age of 27 in an apartment in Bratislava (Czechoslovakia) on 24<sup>th</sup> August 1951. Because of the secrecy of the celebration, it had to be done somewhat speedily in case the secret police burst into the apartment and upset the flow of occasion! For the first 9 years of his ministry as bishop he worked by day in a factory and as a security guard by night. In 1960 he was arrested and sentenced to 12 years imprisonment. His fellow prisoners included 6 bishops and almost 200 priests. He was released during the Prague Spring of 1968 and celebrated the Eucharist for the first time in public.
