Fr Hermann Scheipers is 98 years old. He was a prisoner in Dachau concentration camp in World War II. Today, he is the only surviving priest from that time and in September he met Pope Benedict during his visit to Germany and actually concelebrated Mass with the Pope.

Questions People ask: *'I am a reader in my parish: will the changes at Mass involve new readings?'* There are 2 books for Mass viz. the Lectionary (for readings) and the Sacramentary (prayers of the Mass). There are **no changes** to the Lectionary so you don't need to get a new book for the readings. (*Intercom*)
