27th **1st Sunday of Advent** we have our own ecumenical afternoon, which is being put together by Roger and team and will end with a Taizé Service beginning at 4pm followed by refreshments. **You** may be invited to help. This is taking shape and several parishioners have been requested to act as leaders for the occasion. Thank you for saying 'Yes'!

First Communion Preparations are now taking place under the guidance of Elizabeth Hague and Judy Burkey. Because of the different ages of the young parishioners, we have a class in the sacristy immediately after Sunday Mass and another class in the presbytery. Parents must approach Fr Hugh to discuss preparations with him directly and **not** with the Catechists. Much parental support is needed here.

Moments of silence at Holy Communion, the Bishops have asked us all to be particularly respectful when receiving the Body and the Blood of Christ in the Eucharist. The one hour fast before receiving the Eucharist is meant to be an hour of preparation for what we shall do together.

Sunday morning parking in Bakewell (and on other mornings too) may be easier than we think. The official line is this: "If you already have a parking badge, you may purchase a 1 hour parking ticket before 11.00am and display it alongside your badge to extend your stay to 12.00 noon. (Maximum extension 1 hour)." So we don't really have to rush away on our Bakewell Sunday mornings unless, of course, there is another reason compelling us!!
