Fr Hugh will be contacting those concerned to see if we can find a time convenient for all. **Adults** can also receive the Sacrament during the Bishop's visit in May.

The Parish Finance Committee is made up of Gerry Smith, Kate Howard, Tessa Clarke, Bernadette Goddard, Ben Roper and Fr Hugh. Gerry Smith (assisted greatly by Shirley) has been our Treasurer for 22 years or more and Ben Roger has served on the committee for over 25 years. Deacon John was also on the committee. At Thursday's meeting, we looked at the budget for the recent adaptations to the inside and outside of the presbytery, the plans for the hand rails at the front door and the next stage will be to get the 2nd floor of the presbytery sorted out. This was recommended after the financial inspection of the parish last year. Headquarters has not given any cheques!
