On changing the legal definition of Marriage: Archbishops Vincent Nichols and Peter Smith have written to every parish in England & Wales this weekend. Their letter is available and further copies can be prepared if called for. It is a statement about the Catholic understanding of marriage and issued in the light of the forthcoming consultation by the Government on changing the legal definition of marriage. We, in the parishes, are asked to consider signing the Coalition for Marriage on-line petition which can be found at www.C4M.org.uk The petition reads:- 'I support the legal definition of marriage which is the voluntary union for life of one man and one woman ... I oppose any attempt to re-define it.'

<u>Card-carrying Catholics</u>: Bishop Seamus Cunningham of Hexham & Newcastle Diocese mentions the *faith card* that will be available shortly for those who would like to have one (*The Tablet* 25 February p. 15). Bishop Seamus says, "*The card is a mission tool ... (a symbol) ... Jesus repeatedly used signs and symbols to teach and to serve his mission."* It will be the size of a credit card so be careful you don't get mixed up with your faith card and your credit card!

The Holy Ghost Congregation will be having two important events later this year viz. a General Chapter to which Fr Uche Njoku has been elected and an elective Provincial Assembly which will discuss future commitments. We are asked to pray for both of these gatherings.
