**The Parish Liturgy Committee** had a very useful meeting on Thursday evening and a new liturgy plan will be prepared for September. Although we do not have many devotions because of the nature of our small rural parish, we felt that even the few we have are not well supported. The quality of our devotional life is poor and we would like to do something to improve it if at all possible.

**Last Monday morning** the Amber Valley Deanery had a meeting to reflect on **You Are Living Stones** (YALS). The fruits of our 2 meetings were presented and copies of John Hesse's summary have been sent to the Bishop's office and other Deanery members. As in our case, the 2<sup>nd</sup> meetings in the different parishes were better attended than the 1<sup>st</sup> meetings. The main conclusion took us in the direction of having employed parish administrators so that the local community can be still bonded together. Volunteers will always be needed in our parishes but holding things together seems to demand that we have a structure that is stable and accountable. We also foresee having at least one priest less if not two in the years ahead. Those present at the meeting unanimously agreed that we have to seek out vocations to the permanent Diaconate.
