Speak Out for Marriage Cards are available for signing and sending to our M Ps. A number of us have already contacted our local M P., Patrick McLoughlin, by e-mail. Now you can send him a prepared written card even though we know his own views on the question of redefining marriage (not on same-sex relationships). We have a right to be heard and he has a duty to listen to his constituents and he ought to know this. Please put a stamp on the cards. You might feel that you have done enough by supporting the *Coalition for Marriage* but it does no harm to let our political representatives know our views once more.

The Season of Lent is just round the corner! Ash Wednesday falls on 13th February; much earlier than last year, and the Liturgy Committee will be discussing our Lent devotions. On the Fridays of Lent we have Mass at 11.30am followed by a short Way of the Cross and, then, soup in the parish rooms. This is reasonably well supported but the Friday evening devotions of the Way of the Cross in Bakewell is poorly supported. Unless we can plan to have 10 - 12 people present for the evening meditation of the Way of the Cross, it may be discontinued as a parish devotion. Individual parishioners can, of course, arrange to meet for this devotion in either one of our churches at times they may wish to arrange. Quite a lot already have various keys and so this could be arranged. You can make your views known to the Liturgy Committee members.

At our recent clergy meeting in Bakewell we were reminded that **Costa Coffee** intends to open a shop in the town. Many people are uncomfortable with this proposal believing that many small coffee shops could be put of business. There is a petition to sign in the town if you have views opposed to this new coffee shop opening.
