We have a right to be heard and he has a duty to listen to his constituents. The first debate on the Bill is **next Tuesday** – you can still write to Patrick McLoughlin to tell him what you think. On radio on Friday morning, one speaker said that our present understanding of marriage goes back 800 years and the word or derivatives are mentioned 3,000 times in our laws.

**The Season of Lent** is just round the corner! Ash Wednesday falls on 13<sup>th</sup> February; much earlier than last year, and the Liturgy Committee will be discussing our Lent devotions **next Thursday**. On the Fridays of Lent we have Mass at 11.30am followed by a short Way of the Cross and, then, soup in the parish rooms. This is reasonably well supported but the Friday evening devotions of the Way of the Cross in Bakewell is poorly attended. Unless we can plan to have 10 – 12 people present for the evening meditation of the Way of the Cross, it may be discontinued as a **parish devotion**. Individual parishioners can, of course, arrange to meet for this devotion in either one of our churches at times they may wish to arrange. Quite a lot already have various keys so this could be arranged. You can make your views known to the Liturgy Committee members but, if you opt for "no change", then you have to be there along with the leader.

**Sick & Retired Priests' Fund:** The 2<sup>nd</sup> collection last week realised £213.85 along with 8 Gift Aid envelopes being used thus adding a further £26.25 to the total amount. As has already been mentioned, every parish will be set a target even if you don't want one! **Peter Peel** and **Tony Hynes** along with the **Social Committee** will be trying to come up with a plan for our parish. **IMPORTANT FOR US TO KNOW:** **DO YOU ALREADY SUPPORT THIS FUND?** If you do, you can let Fr Hugh know confidentially so that we will have information as to how much this fund is already receiving from parishioners i.e. people who to come to our church. At present we have four parishioners who support it: Gift Aid will be an important part of our response.
