From Bishop Malcolm's recent diocesan news:

Preparing for the future means that parishes will have to work together. Neighbouring parishes will be called upon to support each other and share their catechetical, liturgical and social life. Fewer parishes will have a resident priest: a parish may have to share its priest with another parish, working together under his pastoral care. It is unrealistic to expect a priest to do everything in one parish and again in another – e.g., two Masses a day, two sets of Easter Triduum, two First Holy Communion and two RCIA courses, and so on. Two parishes working together with one parish priest is already happening in some places, e.g., Beeston & Wollaton, and Spalding & Holdbeach – and, most recently, Newark & Southwell. There will be more of this.

Today there is a very nice prayer card that has been prepared for our Diocese and which is mentioned in the Bishop's Pastoral Letter. It's a little reminder of our journey through the *Year of Faith* that Pope Benedict launched last October. Our Mass in Hassop last Sunday was our own little effort to help our younger parishioners as we make this journey together – many thanks to all who helped us then.

Money Matters! Nigel Trend who looks after our Gift Aid corner will be giving us an up-date in the near future. However, there is some immediate information to give to you. As from the new tax year, there will be new Gift Aid forms for any new 'members'. Parishioners already supporting the parish through Gift Aid will not have to do anything. Those of us who use the weekly envelope system don't have to worry either. Apart from reducing the tax concession to us from 28p per £1.00 to 25p per £1.00, there is now a new possibility for parishes as well. Loose cash is now gift aidable for different places of worship. There is a cap on the amount and, in our case, with 2 churches, we can claim on the loose cash offered in both places. However, Counters will have to keep 2 separate sheets in files – one for Hassop & one for Bakewell! There is no column for £50.00 notes – only £5s, £10s & £20s!!!
