From Bishop Malcolm's recent diocesan news:

Preparing for the future means that parishes will have to work together. Neighbouring parishes will be called upon to support each other and share their catechetical, liturgical and social life. Fewer parishes will have a resident priest: a parish may have to share its priest with another parish. It is unrealistic to expect a priest to do everything in one parish and again in another – e.g., two Masses a day, two sets of Easter Tridiums, two First Holy Communions and two RCIA courses, and so on. Two parishes working together with one parish priest is already happening in some places, e.g., Beeston & Wollaton, and Spalding & Holdbeach, etc. There will be more of this.

The work of catechesis i.e. of offering faith encouragement and faith formation to members of our parish family **must** continue if the parish community is to have any feeling of vitality within it. Because we do not have a parish school, we depend on parents or adult supporters to help in this work of faith formation. So, if there are any young parishioners or adults for the Sacraments, please have a quiet word with Fr Hugh.

Money Matters! Were mentioned last week. Nigel Trend will soon give us an up-date re Gift Aid. More & more of us are using the "occasional" white envelope for weekly offerings – thank you for this. *Every little helps!* However, there is some immediate information to give to you. As from the new tax year, there will be new Gift Aid forms for any new 'members'. Parishioners already supporting the parish through direct banking or weekly envelopes don't have to worry. If they have agreed to Gift Aid, it is all in order. If you want to discuss matters further, please contact Nigel or Fr Hugh. Loose cash is now gift aidable for different places of worship. There is a cap on the amount and, in our case, with 2 churches, we can claim on the loose cash offered in both places. However, Counters will have to keep 2 separate sheets for these – one for Hassop & one for Bakewell! After Easter, we shall be having a Counters' evening just to bring ourselves up to date.
