**Our parish accounts** have been approved and sent to the Diocesan Finance Office. Tony Hynes, Bernadette Goddard and Theo Dengel spent most of last Saturday morning making sure they were in order and 'fit for purpose'.

**A few people** ... have said that our Gift Aid method now seems more complicated. It may *sound* more complicated but in fact it is quite easy. At present, our Gift Aid avenues are the weekly, monthly, quarterly or yearly donations made to support the parish. A signature of acceptance has always been required otherwise claims could not be made. This needs to be done only once and can be withdrawn. A few years ago we introduced the "occasional white" envelopes that are available for visitors and regular parishioners to use. Again, signatures must be given otherwise claims cannot be made. However, since 1<sup>st</sup> January this year, the wording on these white envelopes is now deemed inadequate hence the attachment to which the Diocesan Finance Office did not raise any objections. This attachment needs to be signed only once for parish records. Gift Aid can now be claimed on the weekly loose plate collections, up to £5,000 per place of worship. We will probably reach this sum in Hassop but not in Bakewell if present figures are any indication.

**Counters** Please note that we have our new system in place now as from last weekend. As you open up the computer you will see **COLLECTIONS** with its own icon. **This is the programme to use.** Bernadette has prepared the counting sheets up to September using some of the procedures we've had in the past along with a few new suggestions being included. It should be less time consuming than before ... but we are dealing with the Pilgrim People of the Church ... and there could be a hiccup or even two! Bernadette will help you if you ask her.
