### Diary of the month:

**3<sup>rd</sup>** The ecumenical Agricultural Service at 2.30pm in the Bakewell Agricultural Centre. Also we have our Holy Hour at 4.00pm. Please feel free to come and go as you wish. The Holy Hour has been a devotion to mark the *Year of Faith* and this devotion will come to an end in December.

**4<sup>th</sup>** 5.00pm **R E Group** meets in the presbytery. The parish Catechists who completed the course in Matlock have kindly accepted to look after this pastoral support effort. Once again, it is an open meeting for all who are interested but we are especially thinking of our younger parishioners and invite parents to come along with the children.

**13<sup>th</sup>** S V P meeting after morning Mass. As many of you know already, Pat Skidmore intends to move nearer to her family and will be leaving the parish. Pat has been the SVP President since Chris Holmes' illness and death last December. We are grateful to Pat for keeping the SVP commitment together in the parish. Mickey Etchells has generously accepted the post of SVP President for the time being and, again, we are grateful for Mickey's generosity and availability. New members can always join us!

**23<sup>rd</sup> Year of Faith** will come to a close on 24<sup>th</sup> November, the feast of Christ the King. On **23<sup>rd</sup> November** there will be a Closing Mass in St Barnabas' Cathedral at noon, which Bishop Malcolm will celebrate. The Bishop hopes that all 108 parishes will be represented in the Cathedral.

**24<sup>th</sup>** Feast of Christ the King with the closing of the *Year of Faith*. We shall have the last Sunday of month Mass for the young of the parish.

**Trip to the Cathedral on 23<sup>rd</sup> November** – there is good news! Roger Burkey and Tim Harding are willing to go and have kindly offered to help with transport. So, it seems that at least 2 cars will be going. Roger can be contacted on 01246 583 382 and Tim on 07808 710177. Early booking is advised and it will be first come, first gets a seat! There is a *Park & Ride* just as one approaches Nottingham and there is a big car park just a few minutes away from the Cathedral. **Our Diocesan Youth Centre (Crich)** is hosting an Advent retreat for young people in year 11 and above from 13-15<sup>th</sup> December in Crich. There is a recommended fee for participants but, if any of our young parishioners would like to attend, the parish will willingly extend a helping hand.

**Samuel Groups** are for single young adults (18-30+), who are wondering what God is calling them to do with their lives. The aim is to help participants discern their direction in life, whether this is to marriage or dedicated single life, to priesthood or consecrated life. It would also suit those who are making decisions about their career, or about spending time as a missionary or volunteer. **Also Fr Christopher Jamison OSB** has contacted every parish in England to remind us of *National Youth Day* on the feast of Christ the King (23<sup>rd</sup> November). Fr Christopher is the National Vocations Director and tells us that the vocations' scene is **not** doom & gloom. There is something happening with vocations but little reported.

**Plans are being made** to have refreshments just for the young parishioners and family members after the last Sunday of month Mass which is usually for our younger parishioners. It will be an opportunity to bring them together and it may develop into something a bit better.

**October 'head count':** for the 4 weekends in October, we had 494 people attending Mass in our parish, giving us an average of 123.5. Last year the average was 122 ... a 1.5 increase has been detected!!!

**November Pious List** envelopes are available in both churches. As in previous years, we can simply put a note in the envelope and these intentions will be remembered at the morning Mass offered in Hassop or Bakewell.

**2014 Sunday Missals and My Little Missal** are available. The special missal for children is in the church so that they can be guided through the steps of the Mass. If parents want to buy a copy, they cost £5 as well.
