However, there is still some fighting going on in Juba, the capital and also in Rumbek the diocese where our three confreres work: Sospeter Kiarie, Nolasco Mushi and John Skinnader. I have been in touch with Sospeter who lives with Nolasco and he says things are okay so far though as you would expect there is a lot of anxiety.*
