Bishop Paul Liu Jinghe a Chinese Bishop died on 11th December 2013 aged 93. He was ordained a priest in 1945 and a bishop in 1981. He was imprisoned 3 times between 1940 and 1960 and in 1970 he was sentenced to a re-education camp and remained under this regime until 1979. Bishop Paul did all he could to promote a visible communion with the Church and communion with the Holy Father even though he went through much suffering and persecution. Julia Palmer has written to every parish in Nottingham Diocese about the *Rite of Election 2014*. We should not be put off by the word "Rite" which, practically speaking, means a time of preparation for reception into the Church.
