**One parishioner** has responded to the invitation to take a step forward re a fuller membership of the local Church community with a view to receiving the Sacraments. That's good news for us who live in our small parish family.

**Lent Groups:** We hope to be holding these groups again this year, using the York Course 'Build on the rock'. I say we hope, because as I write this, we have only two groups that are willing to run, and these are both Methodist. As this is an ABC initiative, then there should be groups hosted by all the worshipping communities. We are looking for people from the Parish Church, the Catholic Church and the Friends, to either lead a course or to host a group in their home. Again, it would have to be done in good time – not on Christmas Eve! Future liturgy meetings will be at 7.30pm.

**Some other decisions were:-** We'll continue to have the Friday soups after Mass during Lent with donations for a charity; we'll continue the short meditation on the Way of the Cross after the 11.30am Mass. An evening Lenten Penitential Service will be arranged for 3<sup>rd</sup> April. An evening Lent activity will be planned by Roger Burkey. First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion are being planned for *Corpus Christi* time, 22<sup>nd</sup> June. Parents can send an email to Fr Hugh so that meetings can be planned. Our Eucharistic Ministers will be re-commissioned at Mass on 1<sup>st</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> June. Another suggestion was to try *ad experimentum* a coming together of married couples for ... a get-together maybe? Our thanks to those who came along for the meeting and who serve the parish.
