**Three suggestions from the pews – part II!** These were made by way of a reply to look at our parish finances mentioned in recent newsletters:

(1) Do you have items of gold that are broken, no longer used or simply redundant? They could be sold for the parish! **No response so far**

(2) Have you reviewed your financial support for the parish in the past 4-5 years? Some parishioners 'on principle' do not support any of our fund raising events saying they contribute to the parish through their weekly, monthly or annual Gift Aid arrangements: maybe this is the time to do a review of what you are doing for the parish. **No response so far – but this can be done with your bank in the private domain!** About 38 parishioners Gift Aid their financial support for the parish.

(3) When you have guests over for a meal and they bring you a bottle of whatever, suggest they do **not** bring a bottle but put a fiver in your "special little bag" for your local parish support! This could be gift aided as well if it's a donation to the parish. **One donation so far towards the church roof repairs – thank you for this!**
