Last Few Days of March:

23rd First Communion preparations in sacristy immediately after Mass for our First Communion young parishioners.

25th Afternoon tea arranged by the St Vincent de Paul Society members in the presbytery rooms. Transport is being arranged and, if you can help, please let SVP know. So far, these arrangements are going well and many thanks to all who have volunteered to help with transport & cakes.

30th Mothering Sunday – following on the feast of the Annunciation plus Mass for our younger parishioners so, please, prepare for the readings, music and intercessions. A practice before Mass is essential for the liturgy to go well.

Next weekend our clocks go forward one hour.

The Solemnity of the Annunciation is celebrated on Tuesday at morning Mass in Bakewell. WE are encouraged to make this a special day in the Liturgical Year. Over to us!

At Wednesday's PPC Meeting 8 parishioners were in attendance (75%) with apologies received from absent members. The agenda considered property matters viz. the roof, guttering & drain-pipes of Hassop church (considered a priority), the ambulatory area of Hassop church with plans & costing prepared by Bill McDermott (project that we have to prepare for); Hassop's heating system in the light of recent comments; the cemetery and its on-going maintenance now entrusted to Tim Harding. Fr Hugh again expressed his gratitude to all who work collaboratively in the parish community but re-stated that, whilst we will always need volunteers to help the success of parish life, there will necessarily be times when we have to pay for work that is done in the parish. He felt that there has to be a regular maintenance of the cemetery. It is a huge task to keep on top of a cemetery that is too big for our needs. Also, further discussions are taking place with the appropriate local authorities re access and parking there. Tony Hynes gave a financial report and pointed out that our parish finances are stable. A full financial report will be made later on this year. The roof repairs on Bakewell church cost £5,780.00 and this expense is not covered by insurance. An insurance claim has been made for Hassop's church roof damaged in the February gales.

CAFOD Collection last week=£443.94+seven parishioners helping further with Gift Aid envelopes. Thank you.

From the Derbyshire Churches & Chapels fund, the parish has received a donation of £36.13 – many thanks!

The Parish Social Committee recently finalized the dates for the **Summer Fair 21st June**, the **Summer BBQ 5th July** for the Holy Ghost Frs, **Quiz Evening 4th October** and **Christmas Fair 29th November**. In order to support the events, please put them in your diaries **now!** You will know already that we have reduced the number of fund raising events because of the poor response.

Many thanks to Roger Burkey and to the 13 parishioners who attended our "Lent extra" on prayer last Thursday evening. It was a very pleasant time together.

The Good Friday walk of witness in Bakewell will be slightly different this year. It will be similar to the Christmas procession through the town. The Parish Church clergy and parishioners are planning the event but they will need our help as well to make it an ecumenical occasion. Over to us!
