### HOLY WEEK BEGINS WITH PALM SUNDAY:

**13<sup>th</sup>** Our Cathedral in Nottingham hosts Stainer's **Crucifixion**, Tickets £7.00 with refreshments provided. It will also be sung in Bakewell Parish Church at 6pm.

**16<sup>th</sup>** Chrism Mass in the Cathedral at 11.30am – Bishop Malcolm celebrates as he prepares to move to Liverpool. His installation will be on 1<sup>st</sup> May in Liverpool Cathedral.

**17<sup>th</sup> Maundy Thursday** – Evening Mass at 8.00pm with the *Mandatum*, the washing of feet as Jesus did at the Last Supper. With this Eucharistic celebration we begin the **Sacred Triduum** – those three special days of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil bringing together the **whole** Liturgical Year in which we celebrate the grace of Christ in our lives. It's up to us **to live it!**

John Jones was ordained in 1815 (just before Hassop church was built). There is a plaque to his memory in the choir gallery. *"The congregation was from 80-100 and 62 Communicants at Easter ... Is the congregation generally regular and edifying? Generally so, with alas too many exceptions."* [John Jones text p 2]
