TODAY, HOLY WEEK BEGINS WITH PALM SUNDAY:

13th Our Cathedral in Nottingham hosts Stainer's **Crucifixion**, Tickets £7.00 with refreshments provided. It will also be sung in Bakewell Parish Church at 6pm.

16th Chrism Mass in the Cathedral at 11.30am – Bishop Malcolm celebrates as he prepares to move to Liverpool. His installation will be on 1st May in Liverpool Cathedral.

17th Maundy Thursday – Evening Mass at 8.00pm with the *Mandatum*, the washing of feet as the Lord did at the Last Supper. With this Eucharistic celebration we begin the **Sacred Triduum** – those three special days of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil bringing together the **whole** Liturgical Year in which we celebrate the grace of Christ in our lives. It's up to us **to live it!**

Bishop of Shanghai dies "Mgr Joseph Fan Zhongliang S.J. died on 16th March, aged 96. He was ordained in May 1951 and four years later was arrested and accused of being a counter-revolutionary. In 1958 he was sentenced to 20 years imprisonment and released in 1978. He was secretly ordained a bishop in February 1985. On 22nd March about 50,000 faithful of Shanghai gathered for his funeral."
