We know we are not perfect but there are many of us who have an interest in the liturgy because behind the words and the gestures is the *fundamental message* of why we come together for worship viz. to be constantly reminded of the redeeming grace of Christ offered through these mysteries of faith celebrated in the community. Our gestures, then, are important – e.g. participating in the Offertory collection by receiving the baskets brought around the church even if we support the parish through our bank arrangements. Our efforts at *trying* to improve the proclamation of the Liturgy of the Word were scrutinised and some suggestions were made about how to use the simple microphone systems we have for both churches. At the time of Holy Communion, coming forward at the appropriate time and leading any visitors at this sacred moment when our reverence is called for. You may have other suggestions to make concerning our liturgies, please feel free to make them and, if possible, we'll act on them.
