**Important Gift Aid Information:** Some good news for taxpayers is that the income-tax-personal-allowances have been raised considerably in recent years and the current limit of income, *before* tax must be paid, is £10,000. The less good news is that for donations to charities, such as the amounts paid to the Church under Gift Aid Declarations, these rely on you paying income tax. *If you no longer pay income tax* and have a current Gift Aid Declaration (or for those giving since before 2000 a Deed of Covenant), it is important that you advise the Diocesan Gift Aid Office through your parish organizer (in our case Nigel Trend). This information has been sent by Mgr McGovern, our Diocesan Administrator and sent to every diocesan parish.

**Thanks to** Tony Hynes, Bernadette Goddard and Tim Harding for preparing our accounts for the Diocese and these have been sent to the Diocesan Finance Office. The parish has also paid a second contribution of £5,000 to the **SRPF**: this is a diocesan fund. We still have £20,000 to pay!

**On 11<sup>th</sup> July** Fr John Beirne CSSp will celebrate his 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ordination with Mass in the Bickley chapel. He asks us to remember him in prayer on that day.
