**The Society of African Missions** (*S M A missionaries*) is a modern missionary community serving the Church in many different countries (very similar to the CSSp missionary apostolate). Melchior Marie Joseph de Marion Brésillac was their founder: he was born on December 2, 1813 in Castelnaudary, in the south of France and died in Sierra Leone on 25th June 1859 aged 46. The **SMA Society** is like a number of modern missionary communities that were founded in 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> century to answer the needs of the Church being felt at that time in an Africa and Asia opening up to different world. Obviously, the missionary and pastoral apostolates of the **SMA's** and the **CSSp** are very similar and mix very easily in missionary situations. Next weekend will give us a chance to support their work with our 2<sup>nd</sup> collection.
