**On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> August** in Hassop church we will remember the outbreak of World War I. The church will be open from 5.00pm to 7.00pm for personal and private visits. The Visitors' Book will be available for those who would like to sign it and, perhaps, remember in a more personal way all who died as a result of that war. At about 6.40pm this time of personal respect will close with Evening Prayer of the Church. If you have other suggestions to offer or would like to do something, please discuss with Fr Hugh and let your friends & neighbours know. Please notify the residents of Hassop village as well.

**Recipes booklets from 28<sup>th</sup> June** – the day Joan was received into the Church – are available in both churches. A number of folks at the reception afterwards asked about the various dishes so generously provided by Joan and her 'entourage' (Brian and co.). Joan & Brian have kindly agreed for donations (£1.00 per copy) to be given to the parish St Vincent de Paul Society. Another chance to help in the work of our parish S V P Society.

**De Paul Trust** hosts a Mass in Westminster Cathedral on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> September (feast of St Vincent de Paul) honouring its 25 years of service to the homeless. Cardinal Nichols will preside at this Mass of Thanksgiving.

**Lord Brennan (President of the Catholic Union)** made an intervention in the House of Lords debate on the **Assisted Dying Bill**: he said, 'My Lords, to make it lawful for doctors to assist people to commit suicide is a profound step. This morning's editorial in the Guardian said that it would change the moral landscape of our nation. A Bill that proposes this therefore demands, whether you are for it or not, rigorous examination ... This Bill dismantles the Hippocratic oath by creating two kinds of doctor: those who will not help you to kill yourself and those who will. I cannot imagine more diametrically opposed medical standards than those.' Lord Brennan's intervention and analysis of the Bill is available on the **Catholic Union of Great Britain** website. Lord David Alton also spoke in the Lords' debate.

**Our choir** will be "resting" this Tuesday evening – so no practice! We thank them all for their faithful Tuesday evening gatherings and, if you can help our members in any way whatsoever, please step forward to do so.

**Gift Aid News:** the parish account will soon receive £4,058.75 the result of 2 quarters claims. It seems our h/q in Nottingham misplaced one of our claims. Tut, tut! We hope that would never happen in Hassop or Bakewell.
