Parish Finance Committees: 'Please find attached the mandatory norms for all our parish finance committees, which will come into effect on 1st September 2014. These were approved by the Council of Priests, and take into account points raised by the Council of Priests and by the Board of Directors, which has also approved them. The College of Consultors has approved them and they should be implemented in every parish before the next financial year begins. I reiterate that every parish is obliged to have a parish finance committee: its role is to be an advisory body to the parish priest.' Last Monday (28th July) three of us went to Nottingham to visit the diocesan archives. Canon Anthony Dolan (archivist) made himself very available to us and we had a good 3 hours with him rooting through the archives pertaining to Hassop. Here's a little snippet: 'In November 1897 (the Rev J McShane) put a new heating apparatus in the church (Grundy's system of warm fresh air) at a cost of £100.9s.8d. This also warms the Sacristy, and stairs to room above, the Choir porch, to tribune (Choir loft) and the hall and dining room of our new Presbytery'. More to come!
