There were 19 concelebrants for his funeral Mass and the evening before Bishop Pat Lynch came to the Bickley chapel for reception of Vincent's coffin. All in all, it was a very fitting tribute and expression of gratitude for his life and service. At end of Mass we had a recording of Mahalia Jackson singing the Lord's Prayer, which had been requested by Vincent, and Juliet very kindly got this sorted out for us!
