matters: *Safeguarding (Disclosure and Barring Service): - The Diocese is required to renew DBS disclosures for those whose original disclosure was issued between 2005 and 2012. For those with an email address, the disclosure can be done on-line. Otherwise, the old-fashioned paper option is still available. Either way, a paper self-declaration form and identity verification form will also need completing and evidence of your identity. Those with an email address will shortly receive an email with a link and instructions to complete the on-line form. Those without email will be provided with a paper form.
