## **Lieutenant Samuel Charles Lindsey Hodgkinson**

#### 1886 - 1915

Born in Baslow and a member of All Saints Parish, Lieutenant Hodgkinson, served in the Royal Australian Navy on the flagship HMAS Australia. In January 1915, he was wounded whilst on exercises off Scotland and later died of his injuries. He is buried in the family grave marked by the white cross at the left hand edge of this cemetery.

His cousin, Captain John Francis Hodgkinson, died in Flanders in 1914, and has a memorial in All Saints Church.
