The October 'head count': the total of people attending Mass in Bakewell was 175 (in 2013 178). The total attending Mass in Hassop was 352 (397 last year). Our total at weekend Masses in both churches was 527 and it was 575 in 2013. You will see that we are fewer people in the congregation despite the enormous crowd we had last Sunday in Hassop. The age of evangelisation is still with us!

Last Saturday the parish accounts were audited by the Diocesan auditor – he comes every 3 years or so to cast an eye over our systems of accountability. He was happy with most things but we had to *convince* him about one or two other matters! Thanks to Tony, Bernadette and Nigel for helping with this 'admin' corner of parish life.
